Group Requirements

After making arrangements with the BCS Warehouse Supervisor, please arrive at the agreed time.

- Minimum age of volunteers is 14 years old.
- Confirm with WS that the agreed number of volunteers will be present.
- The adult supervisor of your group will sign a Volunteer Release Form for all listed people on group release form.
- Beverages are provided while volunteering.
- An orientation tour will be given. Ask lots of questions!

What to Wear

- Comfortable and ready-to-get-dirty clothes are great! <u>Shoes must cover the entire</u> <u>foot and have good rubber soles.</u>
- Dress for the weather, i.e., in the winter wear warm clothes; in the summer, cool clothes—but no muscleman tank tops.
- Please, no perfume.

Safety
